- Conducting formative research and mentoring staff and stakeholders on the use of formative research findings.
- Designing appropriate and evidence-based SBC strategies and action plans.
- Assessing capacity building needs.
- Conducting Training of Trainers (ToTs) and orientations sessions on SBC concepts and methods.
- Integrating SBC into current, new, or scaled up nutrition and WaSH activities, such as CMAM, micronutrients, IYCF-E, IYCF, and hygiene promotion.
- Designing M&E tools and indicators for SBC interventions, and evaluate SBC interventions.
